- Sun 28 Jun The group will meet at the Continental Airlines desk at Austin Int. Airport no later than 10:30 AM.

- Mon 29 Jun Arrive Paris (CDG) 7:45A. After Passport Control, baggage retrieval and loading of your bus to meet your driver (Cor Labots) for the tour you proceed to downtown Paris. Late morning ride on the Seine river at Bateaux Mouches prior to your hotel check-in. Lunch at selected place, dinner in hotel.
- Tue 30 Jun PARIS: 9-11am: two-hour highlight tour this morning hosted by our favorite guide, Pierre Verduron. Rest of day at leisure, optional coordinated dinner this evening at Taverne du Sergeant Recruteur.
- Wed 01 Jul PARIS: Free day, ask Colin or Anna for options. Dinner on your own.
- Thu 02 Jul Lv. Paris 9am sharp, to Lyon (4 hrs 40 min + rest stop). Shortly after hotel check in, drive to Vienne to perform at Jazz A Vienne, one of the outstanding jazz festivals in Europe.
- Fri 03 Jul LYON: Lv Lyon 9am sharp. 12:30pm performance in Geneva at The United States Mission to The United Nations for their 4<sup>th</sup> of July event. Leave @ 2pm and go directly to Glieze for shared performance this evening with the "Big Band de L'Ouest" at the Beaujolais Festival. 45-minute performance around 10:15pm. Otherwise, day at leisure in Lyon. Dinner on your own if you do not go to Geneva or Festival.
- Sat 04 Jul To Montreux this morning. (2.5 hr + rest stop). Lunch stop enroute in Geneva or Lausanne. 4:30pm performance as part of the Montreux Jazz Festival.
- Sun 05 Jul MONTREUX: Day at leisure to enjoy this lovely French-speaking city that borders Lake Lemman with the French Alps in the distance. An AM visit (via lake boat) to Chillon Castle. 3pm festival performance today.
- Mon 06 Jul To Grindelwald. (2 hr+) This picturesque "Glacier Village" sits in a valley surrounded by mountains and glaciers and is one of the favorite destinations for Europeans and world travelers alike. Lots of opportunities for hiking in the area.

- Tue 07 Jul To Lucerne today. (1 hr 30 min+) Enroute you will pass through Interlaken and Brienz and over the pass to your Lucerne hotel. This city is characterized as one of the most beautiful cities in all of Europe.
- Wed 08 Jul LUCERNE: Ample time today to sightsee and shop. There are numerous opportunities to experience the German-speaking Swiss lifestyle and to shop in a great variety of unique stores. Dinner-on-your-own this evening. Fondue?
- Thu 09 Jul Into Germany this morning to Bacharach. (4 hr 30 min + rest stop and lunch). On arrival at Bacharach you will board one of the large Rhine River excursion boats. In an hour+ journey you will pass many of the famous castles and cathedrals that border the river. You will disembark at the riverside town of Boppard and walk to your hotel for the night. Dinner in hotel.
- Fri 10 Jul To Rotterdam this morning. (4 hr + rest stop + lunch). Performance at North Sea Jazz Festival. Tickets provided. This is arguably the finest jazz festival in Europe and attracts a number of excellent European jazz artists as well as many of the finest American artists. Dinner-on-your-own at festival (many food booths available).
- Sat 11 Jul ROTTERDAM: A visit this morning to Amsterdam. Those people staying for Concertgebouw concert will coordinate w/Anna, those going to festival will come back on bus and coordinate w/Colin. If not going to concert or Festival, evening on your own.
- Sun 12 Jul To Schiphol International Airport (Amsterdam) – EARLY – for flight check-in.
